However, due to the high infection rates, the traditional Christmas event in December has had to be cancelled, so this year's total visitor numbers were 25,611, with which we cannot be dissatisfied.

On the association front, Bytrafik has appeared entirely regularly, but most of our member meetings had to be cancelled – and the same applied to all three of our planned trips abroad.

While we look forward with anticipation to 2021, we would therefore like to direct our sincere and warmest thanks to partners, authorities, volunteers and association members, and our very best wishes for a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year to you all!
